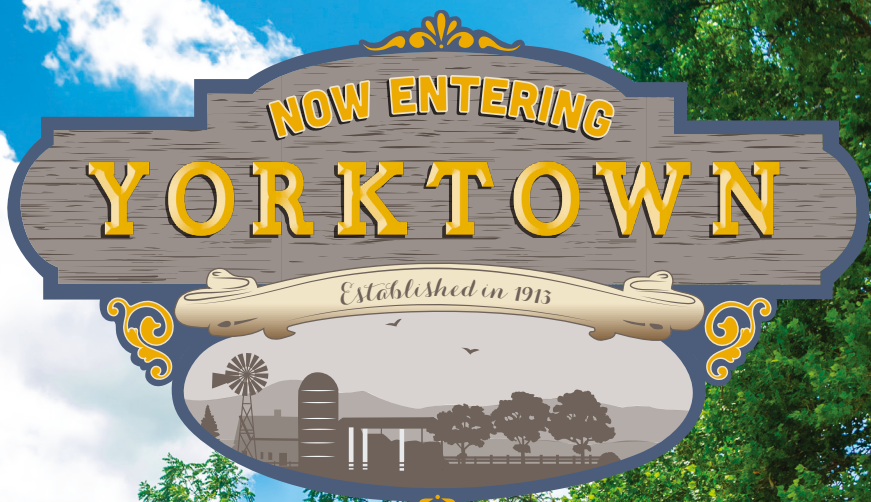

The new leader of Zimbabwe’s opposition party, MDC, Nelson Chamisa, is challenging the old guard, ZANU-PF, represented by the acting president, Emmerson Mnangagwa. The 2018 general election serves as the ultimate test for both the ruling party and for the opposition. How will they interpret democracy in a post-Mugabe era – in discourse and in practice?

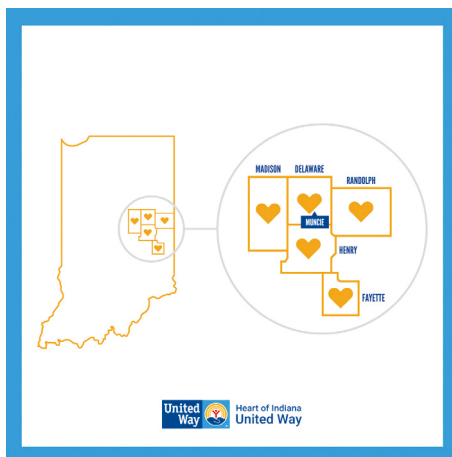
As a partner and advocate for its community, it makes sense why Heart of Indiana United Way is passionate about underwriting for Indiana Public Radio and Ball State PBS.
